THOUGHTS FOR THE MONTH

Recently, I found myself walking down the street behind a young Dad. He had tattoos up his neck and was wearing a black sweatshirt with the word “Nasty” printed on the back. I know you can’t judge a person by their appearance, but coupled with this guy’s behaviour towards his young son, I was left with the impression that he didn’t have a father’s heart. He was walking in front of his son and looking at his cell phone, oblivious to his son’s attempts to keep up with him or his obvious hopes of being acknowledged.

As they entered a car park, the Dad grabbed his son’s hand. “Great!” I thought, this guy’s proven me wrong; he does care about his son. I noted that the child appeared fairly well adjusted despite having a Dad who looked like he’d slipped through prison bars. The car they got into had an older, respectable looking gentleman at the wheel. This must be “Nasty’s” Dad I thought; taking his son and grandson out for a ride, encouraging his son to take an interest in his child. I then wondered if “Nasty” had grabbed his son’s hand as he came into view of the older gentleman so that his father would think he was making an effort and caring for his son. Perhaps it had all been for show, and it was the grandfather who really cared.

This incident reminded me of **1 John 2:15** -

“For when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you.”

Any love the world appears to have is just for show; it’s not real. “Nasty” was caught up in his own little world, leaving his young son racing to keep up with him, and hoping for his Dad’s attention and love. How often have you and I been like “Nasty” and missed an opportunity to love people because we were caught up in our own little worlds? Let’s remember the words of **1 John 4:11** -

Delightfully loved ones, if God loved us with such tremendous love,

then “loving one another” should be our way of life!
